









waitress who yells in fear, a man tries to stop her but she pushes him and continues her mad race.





For now, the matter will be investigated discreetly and security measures will be increased. But something is clearly out of the question. There's a lot more to this trial than meets the eye.







A terrible **crime** to be cleared up.

RICARDU



we will see the daily life of this group of people locked up in the hotel. Skin deep feelings, exacerbated by the lockdown, the attractions, seductions, hatreds...

Their deliberations, during which we will, through **flashbacks**, piece together the trial.

Their relationships beyond the deliberation room. How the use of power games has influence on other's opinions. It takes **7 votes to find the defendant guilty. And 5 for him to be declared innocent.**

An **international soccer player** in his professional and personal prime, the husband of a well-known model, is **accused of murder**: that of **a fan who was about to publish some compromising photographs of him.** The soccer player has no alibi. **The case has polarized the public opinion.** Many people hope hat his innocence will be proven... but it would also benefit many if he were convicted.
